Re: Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Compliance

Dear Sensors Customer,

This document outlines Sensors Unlimited's stance with the RoHS Initiative stated below.

In 2004, the European Parliament passed the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) directive to "protect human health and the environment by restricting the use of certain hazardous substances in new equipment." Article 4 of Directive 2002/95/EC states that beginning July 1st, 2006; new electrical and electronic equipment put on the market does not contain lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) or polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE). National measures restricting or prohibiting the use of these substances in electrical and electronic equipment which were adopted in line with Community legislation before the adoption of this Directive may be maintained until 1 July 2006.

Because Sensors Unlimited's products fall under multiple current RoHS exemption categories, including monitoring and control, large stationary industrial installations, military, aerospace and telecom/networking infrastructure, our products typically fall outside the scope of the directive. We continue to monitor environmental legislation that may impact Sensors Unlimited and its customers and we are actively working with supply chain partners to develop alternative lead-free solutions.

As always, Sensors Unlimited will actively work with customers to ensure we meet their needs in terms of environmental compliance.
